Symphony of Silly Instruments

Traditional Tune Adaptation, Additional Words, and Guitar Chords by ELEG for SBWE

Create a collection of silly instruments, examples include: tambourine, egg shaker, jingle bells.

Get volunteers, pass out instruments. Line kids up so you can see them. Each instrument gets a verse, then the third line of the song repeats, accumulating the silly instruments as you go.

Last verse, everyone plays all at once in the symphony.

Any kid not playing an instrument is a SYMPHONY SINGER along with me!
